The check-in will be on Sunday (the day before the start date of the course), and the check-out will be on Saturday (the day after the end of the course)

In exceptional cases, check-in on Saturday or check-out on Sunday may be authorized, in which case the price of the additional weekend nights will be €48.00 per person in a single room and €37 per person in a double room.

▶ FAMILY ACCOMMODATION

Homestay accommodation is an interesting way to deepen your knowledge of the Spanish language and practice using the language in everyday situations.

It is essential to be enrolled in the courses in order to reserve accommodation.

REGISTRATION

Our course programme is designed for adults. Where students between the ages of 16 and 17 wish to register for a course, they must fill in and send an <u>Underage Authorisation form</u> (available on our website), signed by their parents or legal guardians, alongside their pe-registration application.

Application and documentation required: Students who wish to register must fill in the <u>Registration form</u> (available on our website), and submit it alongside the following documentation:

- A photocopy of the student 's ID document or passport
- For under-18s, the authorisation form signed by the student 's parents or legal guardians

Once the Secretary's Office receives the Registration form, students will be sent a budget, as well as instructions on how to pay the enrolment fees. Where students also request accommodation in our halls or residence, the price will be included in the budget.

The course and registration fees must be paid after the budget is sent and the student's place is confirmed. Applicants will have 10 days to make the corresponding payment.

Payment can also be made by **credit card**. If the student chooses this method of payment, he/she must expressly inform the Secretary so that access to *online* payment can be facilitated.

ACCOMMODATION

The UIMP (Universidad Internacional Menéndez Pelayo) has its own accommodation in university residences that are available to students enrolled in the Spanish Language and Culture Courses.

Students who wish to request accommodation must indicate this on the pre-registration form.

LEVEL TEST

Before arriving at the UIMP, all students will be able to take an online level test to find out their approximate level of Spanish and, based on this test, they will be provisionally assigned to a group.

On Monday afternoon, after the teaching team has assessed the results of the level test and the perfomance in the classroom of each student, the final results of the level test will be published on the information boards, indicating the surname an first name of the student, the assigned classroom and the name of the Spanish Language teacher.

Students enrolled in Spanish courses who have not previously taken the online level test must sit a level test on their first day in order to allocate them to the corresponding group and class.

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES OR SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS

Students with a physical, mental or sensory disability, or who have special educational needs, must notify the university before booking a course, so that the centre may advise them about the suitability of the selected course. Although the UIMP shall do its utmost to support them, it cannot guarantee that the specific needs of these students will be covered.

ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATES

Students will receive an attendance certificate at the end of their course, in accordance with the European Common Framework of Reference (ECFR), stating the level and class load.

In order to be awarded the certificate, students must attend at least 85% of the Spanish Language and Culture classes, taking into account the class hours stated in the corresponding information table and as per the period of stay for courses.

CANCELLATION, WITHDRAWAL AND REFUNDS

- Course cancellation: In the event that the university cancels a course or level, students will be refunded the full amount paid for enrolment and admin fees or, where they so request, they may use this amount for another scheduled course in the same academic year.
- Enrolment withdrawal: In the event that students wish to withdraw their enrolment on a course, and in order to be refunded, students must notify their intention to cancel their enrolment to the Student Secretary's Office in writing before the start of the course, providing the reason for said cancellation and attaching the relevant accreditation documents.

Enrolment withdrawal requests shall be processed as per the following deadlines and amounts:

- For enrolment cancellation or withdrawal requests submitted seven calendar days or more before the start of the course, the enrolment fees shall be refunded in full
- For enrolment cancellation or withdrawal requests submitted under seven calendar days before the start of the course, 75% of the enrolment fees shall be refunded
- No refunds shall be made after the course has started

Exceptional circumstances or due to force majeure for the student, will be studied individually, upon submission of official documents accrediting this situation.

The registration admin fee (22.50 euro) shall not be refunded where students request cancellation.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

Fees for medical insurance are not included in the enrolment fees.

- We recommend all the students from European Union member states bring form The European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), so they may use the Spanish public service where necessary.

- Students from non EU national must take out a medical insurance policy before travelling.

VISAS

European Union citizens do not need a visa to attend the courses.

Non-EU citizens must consult their nearest embassy or consulate regarding any requirements to study in Spain. Students who request a UIMP admission document to process a visa application at Spanish embassies or consulates must have paid the full fees for the course they have enrolled on beforehand.

Once payment is received, the admission letter will be sent to the address provided by students. The document will contain student's personal details, ID or passport number, the period where they will take the UIMP courses and, where applicable, the accommodation address during their stay.

Where the visa is denied, the UIMP will refund the fees paid as long as students notify the university in writing before the start of the course. They must submit the official notification document sent to them by the embassy or consulate refusing the visa and the reasons provided. The registration admin fee 22.50 euro) shall not be refunded in any instance.

DERECHOS DE IMAGEN
