- Societal challenges and STI policy. International cooperation to address societal challenges. Mission-orientation in Horizon Europe and other OECD countries: its implementation, scope and limits. New innovation policy frames: transformative innovation, policy labs, grassroots policies.

- Assessment and evaluation STI policy. How can evaluation practices adapt to the changes in objectives and focus of STI policy? How can relevant evidence be collected, interpreted and used?
